

POA Neighborhood Minutes for March 24, 2024

Rene Webb, president of POA, called the meeting to order. Rene introduced board members to the members.

Easter festivities will be on Saturday, March 30th, from 1-3. There will be hunting for ages 0-5 from 1:15-1:45. Bingo will be played for the older kids during this time. Kids from ages 6-11 will hunt from 1:45-2:15 and younger kids will play bingo. The Easter Bunny will be here for pictures.

The Yard Sale will be in April 6th. Rene will send a notice for participants so signs can be distributed.

Yard waste pickup will be on April 13th. Yard waste needs to be out before 8:00. We will contact the counselor at Harmony Grove to see if any students would come and help Joe so it could go towards the volunteer credits they need for graduation.

A dumpster will be available on April 15-17. First day will be for furniture and large items. Cardboard will need to be broken down. The dumpster will have a new location of Glen Abbey to help prevent people from other neighborhoods from using it. No paint or chemicals can be placed in the dumpster.

Rene thanked Joe Dixon for clearing the ice for us and for all the pickleball and golf volunteers. She also encouraged members to volunteer when needed.

Rene also wanted to thank Fence Brokers for their donation of fireworks for the 4th of July. She mentioned talking with them and members about several needing a fence and possible pricing if a large number were interested.

The pool has been a problem with getting someone to work on a commercial pool. The cost of the big pool has been hard to get anyone to give a reasonable cost. She said that Stacey and Stephanie have talked with a person who they are waiting on for a quote. The POA is also taking bids on fixing the leak we have and getting the plumbing up to code.

Suggestions from members on the big pool were to concrete the area and make it an area like a cabana and possibly areas to grill. Basketball courts and a playground were also mentioned. Danny Dixon mentioned that District 30 could possibly look at the bond and use some of the money from the bond to help with the pool expenses. Members asked if we could have a key fob for members to use for the pool to keep people who

are not members out. Rene encouraged members to ask where people live so that we can monitor that problem. Members suggested we send out a questionnaire to POA members and see what their priorities are for Silver Springs. Rene said we would put one on the website.

A question was asked about the liquor store and Kyle said it is not opened but sometimes opened for tournaments.
